SECURE CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

#1 Priority-STUDENT SAFETY



- 1. Visitor will be “buzzed” in by school personnel.**
- 2. Visitor must report to the office.**
- 3. Driver’s license or state issued identification is required.**
- 4. Visitor logs in and identification is scanned.**
- 5. Pass is printed out for visitor with picture, date, destination.**
- 6. Immediately identifies registered sex offenders.**

NO EXCEPTIONS

Procedure for students arriving after 8:10 a.m.

- 1. Parent must accompany student to the office.**
 - 2. Parent will sign student in.**
 - 3. Tardy pass will be printed for the student to take to class. A tardy will count against perfect attendance.**

Procedure for students leaving before 3:05 p.m.

- 1. Parent must come to the office.**
- 2. Parent will sign student out.**
- 3. An early out will count against perfect attendance.**

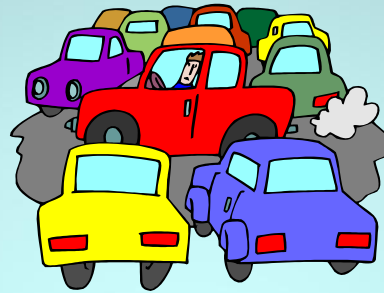
