(One unit can be Marching Band with <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> P.E. required. Athletics including cheer, dance, sports, and JROTC fulfill requirement.)

#### \_\_\_\_\_ Health & Safety - ½ unit

#### \_\_\_\_ Fine Arts - ½ unit

(Band, Choir, Orchestra, Music Theory, Music Appreciation, Theater, Stagecraft, and/or Visual Arts)

### \_\_\_\_ Oral Communication – ½ unit

(Debate or completion of English 10)

#### \_\_\_ Elective Credits – 6 units

(Examples: Literacy Ready, Foreign Language, additional courses in Social Studies, Math, Science, Business, Career and Technical Courses, etc.)

# **Twenty-three (23) units minimum** are required for high school graduation. Only two (2) of these units may be in physical education, with a maximum of one unit per year.

NOTE: A student identified as disabled, as per State Department of Education definition of disabled, may be graduated by meeting the requirements above or by completion of his/her IEP (Individual Education Program) as established by the student's programming committee.
