Belle Point Center GED Prep Program Guidelines 2019-2020

Any student that is 17 years old or within one month of their 17th birthday wanting to be accepted into the Belle Point GED Prep Program must take the TABE test given on Tuesdays and Thursdays at Belle Point Center. The student needs to arrive by 9:00am with a **State Issued Photo ID**. Allow approximately 4 hours for the test.

TABE Testing Dates:

- August 22nd, 27th, 29th
- September 3rd, 5th, 10th, 12th, 17th, 19th, 24th, 26th
- October 1st, 3rd, 8th, 10th, 15th, 22nd, 24th, 29th
- November 5th, 7th, 12th, 14th, 19th, 21st
- December 3rd, 5th, 10th, 12th, 17th
- January 7th, 9th, 14th, 16th, 21st, 23rd 28th, 30th
- February 4th, 6th, 11th, 13th, 18th, 20th, 25th, 27th
- March 3rd, 5th, 10th, 12th, 17
- April 2nd, 7th, 14th, 16th, 21st

Once the test is completed it will be scored and the students will receive their score. The student must score a minimum of: **537 in Math, 536 in Reading, 547 in Language,** to qualify for the program.

If the student qualifies for the GED Program a time will be set up for them to enroll and the following guidelines must be adhered to upon admittance:

- 1. Dress Code Students must adhere to Fort Smith Public Schools guidelines.
- 2. Students need to arrive no later than 7:55am to be searched and scanned every day. GED program will begin at 8:00am.
- 3. Students will be dismissed Mon, Tues, Wed, Thur, Fri at 12:00pm
- 4. Students will not receive academic credit while enrolled in the GED Prep Program.
- 5. Students will adhere to all other policies of the Fort Smith School District and Belle Point Center
